





## Coronavirus support and information: where to get help

# If you are in a high-risk category, you should stay at home. The following organisations can support you.

#### **Stony Stratford Coronavirus Support Group**

A system of local volunteers who are supporting their elderly, vulnerable and selfisolating neighbours with shopping, prescriptions or just a chat. Based on Facebook, this group aim to have every street in Stony Stratford, Galley Hill and Fullers Slade covered by someone.

### Adult Social Care: Local Support Services: 01908 252 398.

If you are in a high risk category (e.g. you are over 70, or you would usually be eligible for a flu jab, or you are pregnant) and have no other local support (ego friends/family/neighbours) and need help to access food or medicine, LSS offer help with shopping, medication and welfare checks.
